



Cambridge Door has been a leading manufacturer of high quality architectural wood products since Canada's confederation in 1867, when Robert Gilholm opened his sawmill on Harris Street, in Galt, Ontario. By 1872, Gilholm was well established within the growing wood manufacturing industry that dominated the area.

Robert Gilholm's sawmill was purchased in 1900 by the P.W. Gardiner Company, and was successfully transformed into a manufacturer of interior and exterior doors. Unfortunately the factory was consumed by a devastating fire in 1923. Rising from the ashes, operations resumed and continued to grow, culminating in a management buy-out in 1974.

In order to embrace its roots in the community, the company was renamed Cambridge Door, honoring the newly amalgamated city formed in 1973 from the communities of Galt, Preston and Hespler. In 2007, the company was purchased by a group of investors with direct knowledge of the industry along with the senior management team.

In the course of becoming one of Canada's oldest door manufacturers, Cambridge Door has acquired generations of tradition and craftsmanship. To these values we add innovative manufacturing techniques continuous new product development, and renewed commitment to customer service.

Our products; flush, stile & rail doors, frames and panels, are known and used throughout the world. Our many satisfied customers are a tribute to our enduring presence and leading role in the industry. We shall continue to develop new products and manufacturing techniques in order to maintain our position as an industry leader in the production of high quality architectural wood products.
